BUTTERSCOTCH BABY SPIREA
Exceptionally compact variety. Foliage is a beautiful,
deep caramel color when first emerging in spring, and
again in fall. Pink summer blooms attract pollinators.

LIL' FLIRT SPIREA

An exceptionally tough and compact variety. Rich burgundy new foliage offsets deep pink flowers that appear in spring and again in summer. Tolerates full sun without burning and adapts to urban settings and poor soils.

LIL' SIZZLE® SPIREA

Packs a double punch with bright orange new foliage that matures to gold, and hot pink flowers that appear in spring, and again in summer. Tough and compact, and adapts to poor, compacted soils.

ZONE: 4-9



WALBERTON'S® PLUMTASTIC SPIREA

Very tidy and compact, with clusters of vibrant purplered buds opening to bright cerise flowers. Reblooms from summer into fall, offset by rich purple new foliage that emerges throughout the growing season. ZONE: 4-9



LIMEMOUND® SPIREA

Bright lemon yellow foliage matures to a vivid lime green on a compact mounding form. Produces lovely panicles of soft pink blooms in summer. Brilliant fall color is provided by the orange-red foliage on red stems.

ZONE: 3-9



YETI™ JAPANESE SPIREA

A profusion of showy white flower clusters for a fresh look. Self-cleaning repeat bloomer (light shearing recommended) stays tidy with a small, mounding form. 2-3' tall. 3' wide.

ZONE: 4-9
